Most phone service carriers have already implemented STIR/SHAKEN* protocols that use digital tokens to verify your Caller ID phone and combat spoofing. Fill out the form below. TTHM will complete the registration of your Caller ID phone number.

The IT Contact listed below will only be contacted by TTHM if carriers receive substantial numbers of complaints about your outreach from call recipients. Using a well-managed internal phone database or a quality purchased phone database will help to limit complaints. TTHM also manages a Do Not Contact database for each client consisting of automated and operator-received DNC requests made by call recipients. We have maintained such DNC databases for our clients since January of 2014, scrubbing DNC numbers from call and text lists to reduce complaints and economize outreach.
